### March 5 ~ Kevin Roy



Everyone loves a good story. Winnipeg Alt-country troubadour **Kevin Roy** shares his songs as if telling a story for the first time over morning coffee. He delivers poignant folk ballads, wry witty toe-tappers, and barnburners with the right balance of aw-shucks honesty and unbridled enthusiasm.

**Kevin** is proud to announce a western Canadian tour in support of his video release for "*The Mighty River*". The song—from his debut "*Heartworn Highways*" LP—is a thoughtful

and sparse tune inspired by the yearly flooding of the Red River valley in Manitoba. The music video was created using footage of the 1950 Manitoba Flood compiled from the *Manitoba Archives*. While touring **Kevin** will be donating all money earned from the song sales to the *Canadian Red Cross*.

If you see **Kevin Roy** down one of life's many highways, tip your hat and buy him a round—it's sure to result in a story or two, and maybe a tune with a bit of old-school twang.

### March 12 ~ Denis Donnelly and friends

Founding VFMS member **Denis Donnelly** returns with friends to perform music from his beloved Ireland in this feature. **Denis** will sing, play guitar and Irish harp, and be joined prominently by his long-time musical partner, the wonderfully proficient **Lanny Pollet**, who will play Irish flutes. Together they will re-create some of the most beautiful and enduring songs and tunes from that amazing tradition.

**Denis** is also bringing in some of his singing friends, including long-time folk favourite **Maureen Campbell**, to lend harmonies to both

slow and gorgeous Irish airs, as well as some lively toe-tapping pub songs.

*Saint Paddy's Day* shows generally tend to be lively sing-along events (and there will be some of that for sure) but **Denis** is also interested in digging deeper into the musical traditions of that musical nation, meaning you'll hear music both fast and slow, familiar and unfamiliar, and traditional and newly-composed.

A rousing Irish time is guaranteed for all. And as they say over there "You're all very welcome!"



### March 19 ~ Glenn Chatten & The Men of Quiet Desperation



It is impossible not to feel the depth of being human, with all of its frailties, joys, sadness, fears, and strengths when listening to one of **Glenn Chatten's** songs. His mastered ability as an acoustic finger-style guitarist combines mesmerizing eclectic rhythms with profound lyrics and melodies. Glenn's song-writing emerges from the "in-between" spaces of life: the spaces between children playing at a park, between a gathering of aboriginal elders, or on a street corner in the downtown east-side of Vancouver.

Having deep respect for the musicians with

whom he performs—**Ken Cade** on violin, **Enrico Renzon** on lead guitar, and **Ross Christopher Fairbairn** on bass—**Glenn's** intent is always to make real everyone's potential, sharing not only the soul-filled joy of music with them but fostering it in other artists in the community.

A participating member of *SAC (Songwriters Association of Canada)* and *Music BC*, the Musical Director of the *Vancouver Youth Theatre*, the Artistic Director of Vancouver's "*Joy Fest*" *Songwriters Festival*, **Glenn** is a highly-respected and established singer/songwriter.

### March 26 ~ Three For Silver

**Three For Silver** runs off the friction of opposing forces. Thunderous bass and dreamy melody, baritone growl and smooth soprano, new music and timeworn style. The band creates a sound that is both wholly unique and yet familiar.

They're the feeling you don't quite have a word for, or the town you just arrived in but could already call home. If it's folk music no one has found the country of origin.

Musical comparisons include such acts as *Tin Hat Trio*, *Man Man*, *Tom Waits*, and *Kronos Quartet*.

**Three For Silver** grew as the brainchild of **Willo Sertain** and **Lucas Warford**, during a long international tour with the *Underscore Orchestra* and was named for a half-mistaken poem recalled once in a dream. They perform primarily as a trio, but also in Big Band format with drums, horns, and strings.

The band has hit the road non-stop since their formation in 2013, playing over 200 shows a year, and have gained an international following with their unmistakable sound.
