December 04 ~ Denis Donnelly's Celtic Christmas



Denis here: I've been putting on *Christmas/Yuletide* Features off-and-on at *The Folk* since at least 1992. This

year I'm bringing along a group of my musical friends including Lanny Pollet (flute), an ensemble of 9 women (all from the *Soundings Vocal Ensemble*), singer/bodhran player Cathy Baker, and Dick Jackson, as well as Stage Designer/actor Zelda Dean. I'll be playing Irish harp and guitar.

My idea is to re-create a Yuletide "kitchen party", taking place in a home somewhere in a Celtic land, long ago. Almost all the music will be traditional, arranged by me – instrumentals, women's vocals, solo as well as in beautiful 3-part harmony,

and, yes, sing-alongs! Baked into it all will be Zelda and Dick offering snippets of folklore and history, as well as lovely Yuletide stories from ages past. Want to know how Yuletide was celebrated on the Shetland Islands? ... How Oliver Cromwell influenced Christmas? ... How a gorgeous Christmas lullaby from western Scotland was written? ... How the Irish harper Turlough O'Carolan dealt with an unwelcome diagnosis? ... How to make a good Wassail Bowl? ... And all the time hear some wonderful and little-known Yuletide music? Then come along!

December 11 ~ Valdy

Returning to our stage for his *fifth feature*, Canada's legendary folkie Valdy is going to brighten up our December!

"I've been lucky," Valdy suggests, when asked about his career's longevity. "I've worked with some amazing people, players, innovative producers, great songwriters." He pauses, pulls his whitening beard. "And I married the right woman."

Another pause, then "Is that luck? Or is that moving at God's speed? I mean, it's more than strategy that puts these folks along my path. Sure I'm good at what I do, and I'm getting better, I'm paying attention, and I'm learning, but I've lived a charmed life, with a supportive partner, a glorious daughter, two vibrant sons, my health intact; I am a really lucky man."

The band plays a heady mixture of Celtic, English, and Old-Time dance tunes, sure to get your toes tapping and your feet heading for the dance floor. Already a mainstay in the local dance scene, look for them at the Victoria Contra Dance Society's events — they are also

available to liven up celebrations of all kinds. Normally a quartet, they will be a trio for this event: *Ian Johnston* on guitar, *Dick Pollard* on fiddle, and *Patty Castle* on bass.

There will be a Caller (TBA at press time) to provide the dancing instructions, so even if you've never danced before, you'll know what to do! If you're not into dancing, there's plenty of room to hang out and catch up with friends and nosh on the potluck goodies.


Please remember the folk club's recommendations of wearing masks and avoiding wearing scents as a kindness to others.

Performer Guidelines (How to please our audience!)

Welcome to the Victoria Folk Music Society's weekly gathering! We hope you enjoy playing here—so here's a bit of performance advice on what works best for our club. Some of the suggestions may seem obvious, while others may not have occurred to you before.

1. **Please be considerate and don't go overtime.** There is a ten-minute limit for open-stage sets and ten minutes goes by fast—especially if you're tuning up, and talking about yourself and your music, as well as playing! Pace yourself accordingly, which means you've probably got time for two songs unless they're particularly short ones. When in doubt, check with the host.
2. **Perform to be heard.** The acoustics are great in this hall, but you still need to project so that the people at the back can hear you. Consider standing up while you perform; otherwise, your sound may not get much beyond the first row. Remember that folk-song lyrics are at least as important as the music. If you're singing and playing, especially in a group, you may need to sing

louder and/or play softer to ensure that your words are heard by all.

3. **Present well-practiced material.** The Folk Club is an excellent place to try out new material with a receptive audience, but it's not the place to "fake it till you make it"! Please respect yourself and your audience enough to practice your material before you perform.
4. **Consider playing a cover song with a chorus** in your set, especially one that's well known. Our audience loves to sing along! If the song isn't well known, prompt us the first time so we know when and what to sing.
5. **Plan to stay and listen to others play.** It's a great way to meet people and also to pick up new material and performance ideas.
6. **Have fun and we hope to see you again!** If you'd like some feedback on your performance, please feel free to ask.

greater than it is in people’s continued willingness to respect others’ sensitivities and concerns, and to even mask-up when inside the club – something increasingly rare everywhere else and yet still strongly recommended by so many health professionals.

As 2023 unfolds, it will be important to build on our strong restart. As a 100% volunteer-run, non-profit organization, the Victoria Folk Music Society’s health and continued well-being depends on all of us stepping up to contribute our time, talents, and good will, so should you find your thoughts turning to resolutions for the new year, please know how valuable and appreciated your contributions to the VFMS will be! **Happy holidays everyone!!**”
